### From the Editor's Desk








Photograph of a metastatic choroidal lesion arising from carcinoma of the lung




Photograph of a Giant Retinal Tear with Detachment

## Practice News: New Office in Braselton



We are thrilled to announce the opening of our newest location in Braselton. Our Braselton office is located in the Riverstone Medical Plaza at 1255 Friendship Road, Suite 160. Dr. Alexander Bottini and Dr. Paul Walia are practicing at this location and are excited to provide retinal care to the Braselton community.

The Georgia Retina Braselton office is fully equipped to provide cutting-edge care to patients with retinal conditions. In addition to state-of-the-art diagnostic equipment, the office is equipped to provide patients with retinal procedures such as intravitreal injections, laser retinopexy, cryosurgery, and pneumatic retinopexy.

### **Clinical Trial Update**

Georgia Retina has a long tradition of commitment to and participation in clinical trials in order to provide our patients access to new, state-of-the-art preventative, or therapeutic treatments. We partner with the National Eye Institute, some of the nation's top pharmaceutical companies, and other clinical practices to explore the causes and cures for many retinal conditions.

Over the years, Georgia Retina has helped pave the way for many new therapies to make it to clinical practice and advance treatment strategies for blinding retinal conditions.

This year Georgia Retina participated in the pivotal Archway trial, which investigated the surgically implanted port delivery system releasing Ranibizumab. This device has earned FDA approval and is now called Susvimo.

We take special care to ensure that our study patients experience the best medical care possible.

This past year we have been active in twenty-six clinical trials for wet agerelated macular degeneration, geographic atrophy secondary to dry agerelated macular degeneration, retinal vein occlusion, diabetic macular edema, and non-proliferative diabetic retinopathy.

We hope that as you consider where to refer your patients for retinal care, you will keep in mind that Georgia Retina not only provides exceptional care but can also offer your patients the opportunity to enroll in clinical trials thereby offering them new vision-saving treatments. ### Spotlight with a Georgia Retina Doctor: Dr. Rahul Komati

For this edition of The Lightpipe, we were able to sit down with Dr. Komati. We are lucky that Dr. Komati joined our practice in 2020 after completing his retinal surgery fellowship at The University of Chicago, which is one of the premier programs in the nation. Dr. Komati is a rising star not only within the practice but in the vitreoretinal field as he is very active in presenting clinical research at prominent national meetings. #### Lightpipe: Why did you choose retina?

**Dr. Komati:** Retina is one of the most fascinating fields in all of medicine, so it was easy to get drawn to it. My med school friends sometimes are puzzled how I could specialize in "just one layer" of the eye. But truthfully, there is so much packed into this tissue that impacts vision and overall health. It's always gratifying to examine a patient's eyes and explain their symptoms or diagnose a condition they might be completely unaware of.

Retina is also a seriously innovative field, which keeps every day interesting and exciting. I like explaining to patients that how we practice today looks completely different from a decade or two ago. Yet it is still challenging and humbling to tell patients that we've reached the limits of our treatment for their condition. I am very grateful to be a part of that.

### Lightpipe: What has been your favorite part of practicing at Georgia Retina?

**Dr. Komati:** Though I haven't been here long, it was clear immediately that Georgia Retina is a special place. Everybody who works here is committed firstly to our patients and providing superb retinal care to our communities.
